Elementary K-6 - At Park IB and Hot Springs Intermediate (HSIS), 100% of the people surveyed felt that the students were benefiting from the IB program. 97% felt that the curriculum is challenging. 95% felt that students that participated in the IB program also had additional interests in other areas outside of school and that the IB program helped foster that interest. 100% rated the IB program at Park and HSIS as a high quality program that is very beneficial to G/T students. 98% felt that it was important to have a K-12 IB program available in the Hot Springs School District, however; only 65% indicated that they would definitely continue on to the next level in the program.
